Also, please have a key with you that day with your slides on it (PPT and PDF) as a backup. Plan.

We will use our master computer to display your slides at the program. You must use our computer on site. We will have a full AV set up.

Please use your slides to provide information that includes (in this order as much as possible)

- 1. Introduction: What is your venture and what market/industry do you serve (consumer/enterprise, banking/hospitality/etc.)
- 2. What is the challenge or problem do you presently solve and will you solve in the USA, and why now (EU and US market data is expected)
 - 3. What is the opportunity (size of market TAM/TOM/SOM in \$ metrics are important)
- 4. Why should anyone trust you or invest in you. List Founders/Partners, Management and Advisors: serial entrepreneurs, resumes, schools, success and achievements (even personal).
 - 5. What is your solution or technology

You may show a 30 sec. video of product, service or app if appropriate.

- 6. How do/will you beat out competitors (you may introduce a Marketing Mix 4P diagram and/or a Sales & Marketing Radar Chart)
- 7. Who are actual customers or partners and what is their response or benefit of your product (present short business cases and show testimonials)
 - 8. How much did you raise and how much are you seeking

PITCH SESSIONS FORMAT AND NETWORKING

The startups pitching are listed in order of presentation in the agenda. There will be two sessions separated by a 5 min coffee break. Each session will start with a 20 minute panel/presentation; followed by startup pitches consisting of a 4 minute pitch and a 2 minute q&a with the panel/judges.
